ARC Portal 8.1 Upgrade Overview

Huron Portal and the ARC system

Applications for Research Compliance (ARC) is USF's implementation of <u>Huron</u> Portal, a platform for research process automation. Huron releases periodic upgrades to this platform to offer continuous improvement of system performance, security and usability. On April 19 and 20, 2019, USF Research & Innovation will perform a major Portal upgrade to version 8.1. This update will introduce changes to site navigation and the user interface. This document provides an overview of some of the more noticeable changes that will impact ARC users.

Changes to Site Navigation

Top Bar Navigation - Homepage and Projects

Portal 8.1 provides an updated navigation bar located at the top of the page. The link to your Homepage, "My Home," has moved from the top right to the top left (1). Links to your Homepage, IRB, IACUC, COI, and Biosafety submissions are displayed at all times in the top navigational bar. Select the ellipsis on the right to display links to additional pages (2).



Finding Follow-On Submissions

In prior versions of ARC Portal, a link to the study was always visible at the top left of a followon submission's workspace. After the upgrade, you'll click the chevron to access the breadcrumb links back to the main study's page.


(Example breadcrumb navigation)
